Dr. Bart Silverman graduated from Fairleigh Dickinson University in 1982 Summa Cum Laude and received his doctorate in Dental Medicine in 1986 from Fairleigh Dickinson Jr. School of Dentistry, where he was a member of the Omicron Kappa Upsilon Honor Society. He completed his Oral and Maxillofacial residency at Westchester County Medical Center in 1989 and was chief resident in his final year. He is in private practice limited to Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in New City, N.Y. and is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Implantology. He has been lecturing in the field of implant dentistry for over 25 years. Dr. Silverman is an attending Physician at Westchester County Medical Center, Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, a Clinical Associate Professor at New York Medical College, Adjunct Clinical Associate Professor Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery New York University School of Dentistry and Surgical Director of NYU Post Grad Continuing Education Dental Implant Program. He is also an Adjunct Clinical Associate Professor Roseman School of Dentistry. Director of Roseman University Maxicourse in Implant Dentistry. Director BWS Dental Seminars. Faculty of Implant Pathways and New York, Chicago, Rutgers, Asia Dental Implant Maxicourses.



Dr. Massimiliano Di Giosia is a Visiting Clinical Associate Professor at IUSD. He completed a residency program in Orofacial Pain at the University of Kentucky, a postgraduate program in Headache Medicine at the University of Turin, Italy, and an Orthodontic residency program at the University of Cagliari, Italy. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Orofacial Pain.



Dr. William Chung earned both a Bachelors of Arts in English with Honors and doctor of dental surgery degree from Case Western Reserve University. He completed Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery residency training and earned his medical degree from Temple University. He has dedicated 19 ½ years at the University of Pittsburgh where he was promoted to Full Professor in the Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery. His clinical interests include reconstruction of maxillofacial trauma, treatment of TMJ disorders, and surgical pathology. NIH funded research focused on regenerative medicine techniques involving replacement options for the TMJ meniscus. AAOMS Committee on Anesthesia consultant and content advisor for national AAOMS anesthesia simulation program. He is currently the Clinical Professor and OMFS Residency Program Director at the Indiana University School of Dentistry.
